We have tried to consolidate a list of the supplies students will need for all of their classes. We have tried to think of everything that they will need on a regular basis for the year, but occasionally students may need to refresh some items (i.e. pencils, filler paper), or we may ask them to purchase an item for a particular project (i.e. science fair). However, this list will be what they need to bring in to start school, and will be the bulk of what they need for the year. Seventh and Eighth Grades

- NIV Bible – 1984 version preferred (**not** NIRV or teen version)
- 4 Pkgs. loose leaf paper, college-ruled
- 1 package of loose leaf graph paper (4-5 grids per inch)
- 2 composition books, 100 pages
- 10 -15 quality #2 pencils
- 1 package of pens (blue or black)
- 1 package of red pens
- 6 plastic or vinyl two-pocket folders with brads inside for inserting notebook paper
- 1 package of colored pencils, sharpened
- 2 - one subject spiral notebooks
- Pencil pouch (include several sharpened pencils, blue/black pens, and red pens in pouch)
- Large eraser
- Ruler--12 inch standard and metric, ones with graduated marks for 1/8, 1/4, 1/2 work best for learning
- Compass--Small interchangeable parts NOT advised, try to get one that looks simple but sturdy
- Protractor—transparent works best
- 1 Scientific calculator (get an inexpensive one that has square root key and some other functions) less than \$10
- Black sharpie – Fine point
- 2 Box Kleenex
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 pack of 3x5 index cards
- One bag of favorite individually wrapped candy for prizes

Pick one additional item from the list below and bring:

- baby wipes
- 1 quart or gallon ziplock bags
- 1 bottle of pump hand sanitizer
- 1 package of construction paper
- 1 package of card stock
