PCS has partnered with a local department store to identify clothing items for daily schoolwear. PCS Schoolwear is required to be worn during the school day unless otherwise directed. ## PCS SCHOOLWEAR GRADES K – 6

- Shirts** White oxford style button down shirts for boys and girls: (long sleeve or short sleeve)  
Polo shirts: black, green, gray or white (long sleeve or short sleeve)  
PCS sweatshirts and t-shirts (sold through PCS' Booster Club) may be worn for the school day.  
Turtlenecks: black, green, gray or white
- Sweaters** Pullovers and v – necks: black, green, gray  
Cardigan sweaters: black, green, gray (a PCS Schoolwear shirt must be worn underneath)  
No undergarments should be visible.
- Pants** Schoolwear pants are identified at Shaheen's: khaki or black – no "skinny fit"  
Jeans that are not patched, ragged or torn may be worn – must be of loose fit.
- Leggings** Girls may wear leggings under PCS Schoolwear skirts and skorts: solid black, white, green, gray
- Track Suit** Black with PCS logo available at Shaheen's
- Kilts** Girls may wear PCS Schoolwear Kilts - available in green plaid
- Skirts/jumpers** PCS Schoolwear skirts/jumpers are available in khaki, black, gray and green plaid.  
Skirts must be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing or sitting.
- Shorts/skorts** Must be the designated PCS Schoolwear shorts/skorts: khaki or black

A "substitute twin" garment is an exact duplicate (identical) in style, color and design with garments identified as PCS Schoolwear. "Substitute twin" items can be found through parent swaps, uniform shops and in patterns for those who sew.

**Hats/caps/hoods** are not to be worn during the school day.

- Belts** A belt must be worn if needed.
- Shoes** Rubber soled athletic shoes with socks should be worn on P.E. days. No shoes with wheels attached. No flip-flops or swimmer shoes.
- Jewelry/Misc.** Only a minimum amount of jewelry should be worn to school by boys or girls.  
Boys: No earrings. No visible tattoos.  
Girls: Small earrings may be worn. Minimum amount of jewelry of other kinds allowed. No extreme makeup. No visible tattoos.
- Hairstyles** No extreme styles or unnatural coloring for either boys or girls.  
Boys: Hair should not be longer than the top of the collar or the middle of the ears, and bangs should be cut above the eyebrows.
- After School** Clothing and accessories should not display graphics or lettering that endorse a message contrary to the Christian mission or rules of the school. On some occasions, students may be asked to maintain a higher standard in order to participate in certain events.

The administration has the right to send home, request the student to change into different garments or refuse admittance to school or to any school function a student who does not comply. Administration has the authority to interpret and enforce the dress code.

## PCS SCHOOLWEAR GRADES 7 – 12

**Shirts** White or black oxford style button down shirts for boys and girls: (long sleeve or short sleeve)  
Polo shirts: black, green, gray or white (long sleeve or short sleeve)

Turtlenecks: black, green, gray or white

**Sweaters** Pullovers and v – necks: black, green, gray  
Cardigan sweaters: black, green, gray (a PCS Schoolwear shirt must be worn underneath)  
No undergarments should be visible.

**Pants** Schoolwear pants are identified at Shaheen's: khaki or black  
All pants are of modest (loose) fit. ("skinny fit" is not appropriate for schoolwear)

**Leggings** Girls may wear leggings under PCS Schoolwear skirts: solid black, white, green, gray

**Track Suit** Black with PCS logo available at Shaheen's

**Kilts** Girls may wear PCS Schoolwear Kilts - available in green plaid

**Skirts** PCS Schoolwear skirts are available in khaki, black and gray. Skirts must be no shorter than the top of the knee when standing or sitting.

**Shorts** Must be the designated PCS Schoolwear shorts: khaki or black

A "substitute twin" garment is an exact duplicate (identical) in style, color and design with garments identified as PCS Schoolwear. "Substitute twin" items can be found through parent swaps, uniform shops and in patterns for those who sew.

**Hats/caps/hoods** are not to be worn during the school day.

**Belts** A belt must be worn if needed.

**Shoes** Shoes must be worn at all times. No flip-flops or swimmer shoes.

**Grooming** No body piercings are permitted except earrings for girls. No spacers, gages or extreme jewelry.

No visible tattoos

No extreme hairstyles, jewelry or make-up

Natural hair dye colors only for boys and girls

Boys: hair should not be longer than the top of the collar or the middle of the ears, and bangs should be cut above the eyebrows.

**After School** Clothing and accessories should not display graphics or lettering that endorse a message contrary to the Christian mission or rules of the school. Appropriate jeans, t-shirts, etc. may be worn for school functions. On some occasions, students may be asked to maintain a higher standard in order to participate in certain events.

The administration has the right to send home, request different garments or refuse admittance to school or to any school function a student who does not comply. Administration has the authority to interpret and enforce the dress code.
