A Note Concerning Tuition Assistance For Current Families:

Priority for Tuition Assistance Awards will be given to re-enrolling families through **March 18, 2018**. After March 18 returning families will not have priority over new families but all applications will be considered in the order they are received. If you are unable to file your 2017 income taxes before this date please file for Tuition Assistance using your 2016 taxes, however, when you do file your 2017 taxes you will need to send a copy to the school.

Tuition Assistance - How to Apply:

FAST - Financial Aid for School Tuition

Tuition assistance awards are based on the family's demonstrated need as determined by a third-party agency that makes financial needs assessments for private and Christian schools. Each award is made for one year only and is based on the availability of tuition assistance funds. FAST is the organization we are using for the independent assessment of each family's financial need. If you wish to apply for tuition assistance you will need to fill out forms online. Please go to the school's website at www.portlandchristian.org, click on the word ADMISSIONS and then select Tuition Assistance and read the instructions for FAST. Click on "Financial Aid Application" and it will take you to the page for PCS financial aid. To see what information you will need to fill out the application click on the word "Instructions" located on the left hand column. Please read the instructions carefully. FAST currently charges \$43 for their services. If you do not have internet access please contact the school business office.

Please Note: If you are eligible to apply for School Choice Scholarships you should ALSO apply for FAST assistance because you may be able to get funds from both programs.

School Choice Scholarships

- School Choice is an independent organization that seeks to help families in Jefferson & Oldham Counties.

Students who meet the following criteria may apply for School Choice Scholarships

1. Live in Jefferson County or Oldham County, Kentucky
2. Entering grades K-6
3. Eligible for assistance under the Federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program
