

PCS SCHOOLWEAR

PCS desires to promote a school culture that honors the Lord and reflects value and respect for each student. As 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 reminds us "...You are not your own, you were bought with a price. Therefore honor God with your body." PCS desires for our school culture to reflect this verse. PCS school wear is identified below and must be worn during the school day unless otherwise directed. PCS school wear is available through PCS and at Shaheen's department store. A "substitute twin" garment (an exact duplicate, identical in style, color and design) with garments identified as PCS school wear may be purchased at other stores.

Tops:

- White oxford style button down shirts for boys and girls (long or short sleeve)
- Plain Polo shirts (no logos): black, green, gray or white (long or short sleeve)
- PCS t-shirts, sweatshirts, hoodies (sold through PCS spirit wear store)
- All shirts must come below your belt when raising your hands
- Pullover and V-neck sweaters: black, green, gray or white
- Cardigan sweaters: black, green, gray or white (with a PCS shirt underneath)
- PCS track suit available at Shaheen's or through the PCS spirit wear store
- No undergarments should be visible
- Jackets must be plain (black, gray or green) or a PCS approved jacket – no non PCS logos

Bottoms:

- Khaki or black uniform pants
- Pants should not be tight fitting
- **ELEMENTARY ONLY:** Plain blue jeans (no holes or rips) may be worn in K-6 grades ONLY · Girls may wear leggings under PCS skirts. Leggings should be solid black, white, green or gray · PCS track suit available at Shaheen's or through the PCS spirit wear store
- Shorts must be a uniform short in khaki or black
- No cargo shorts or pants
- Belts must be worn if needed

Dresses/Skirts:

- Skirts/jumpers are available through Shaheen's and are available in khaki, black, gray or PCS plaid
- Skirts should be NO MORE than 2 inches above the knee when SITTING or STANDING
- Biker shorts recommended under skirts, especially elementary due to playing outside and PE

Grooming/Jewelry/Shoes:

- No body piercings except earrings for girls
- Small earrings are recommended for elementary girls due to playing outside and PE
- No visible tattoos or body art (including writing)
- Hats and hoods are not permitted during the school day
- No extreme hairstyles (including unnatural hair color), jewelry or make-up
- Facial hair must be neatly trimmed
- Boy's hair should not be longer than the top of the collar or the middle of the ears and bangs should be cut above the eyebrow or neatly in a bun or ponytail
- Shoes must be worn at all times
- Elementary students must have backs on their shoes due to playing outside and PE
- No flip-flops or house shoes

After school clothing and accessories should not display graphics or lettering that endorse a message contrary to the Christian mission of the school. The administration has the right to send home, request a student to change, or refuse admittance to any school day or function for those who do not comply.
